

Father Theodore's Message

My beloved brothers and sisters in Christ,

So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all and especially for those of the family of faith. *St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians (6:10)*

Happy New Year! (As many of you are familiar, September 1 is the beginning of the new Ecclesiastical/Church Year.)

As we enter the fall months of September, October, and November, we see on the horizon our annual Greek Festival. Glory to God that we can have our festival back in its entirety for the first time since 2019! However, this is not the only event that we have coming up as we move back into a busier season of church life. We celebrate our parish's name day on

September 14th, and this year, we will introduce something new with a Cross Dive. Diving for the Cross is a traditional Orthodox occasion which can take place a couple of different times in the year. One of those times is at Theophany – we may have seen this in Tarpon Springs, Florida, or perhaps videos of people jumping into the icy water in Russia. Another one of those times is at the Feast of the Cross itself: September 14. His Eminence, Metropolitan Alexios, has given us the opportunity to host other Orthodox parishes from around the area and show them hospitality at the occasion of our parish's name day!

Naturally, when we have events planned, this necessitates the chipping in of many hands together for the success of said event. As mentioned, we have a few of these events coming: the 15th Annual Greek Festival and the Cross Dive that I just wrote about. Yet, we have an event every single Sunday when we host the faithful in our Holy Church for the Divine Services, the Coffee Fellowship, Sunday School, and other activities. Every time the doors of our buildings are open, our hands in plenitude are necessary for the completion and success of what we set out to do as Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Church. We must not lose sight of that reality.

As St. Paul writes above, when we have the opportunity, let us (this is a subjunctive – an invitation) work for the good of all – and especially the family of faith: our Church family. In the original Greek of this verse, the following word is present: **oikog.** This is the ancient Greek word for a house/household. Within our Holy Cross Church, we are part of an oikos, a household of faith. And we should honor each other and our household as such. One of those most important of ways is to work together for the betterment of the household – and this is an invitation to do just that. This is not just an invitation to those who might not be helping. It is also an invitation to those who may help a lot to facilitate that invitation to others. For some, it is easy to gravitate into their place and assist in the things of the life of Holy Cross. For others your niche might not be so obvious. That does not mean that you don't have a place here: the work and efforts of *every single person's hands* are valuable and valued by the church family, especially by me, the priest. As we facilitate these wonderful events going forward, let us utilize this time to assist one another in finding our place in our Holy Church and to build up and strengthen our family of faith. Seek out a place where you know you can utilize your talents, reach out to others and ask them to work alongside you, let us, as St. Paul says, encourage and build up each other. (I Thes. 5:II) Amen!




